OVERALL PORTFOLIO OBSERVATION


Social and Governance Performance are good, but Environmental Management is lacking

PORTFOLIO HIGHLIGHTS

- Racial minority representation at the board level is excellent (61.8%)¹
- Employee turnover rate is extremely favorable (4.6%)²
- Percentage of female representation in management and overall employees is high (38.1%)³

KEY PORTFOLIO RISKS

- 1. E: All respondents are using 100% Grid Electricity (no renewable energy)
- 2. **S:** 14.2% of respondents have female representation in Exec. Mgmt.³

KEY PORTFOLIO OPPORTUNITIES

- 1. E: Adoption of renewable energy sources
- 2. S: Diversification of gender representation at the Executive Level
- 3. G: Introduction of basic environmental policies




